#### 3. Charter Revisions

a. In March 2011, we welcomed new leadership to our school. With this change in administration, we have also identified areas of growth for our institution. As we prepare for our fourth operational year, the primary goal of Bronx Academy of Promise is to increase the effectiveness of our assessment procedures. To this end, we request to amend the Terra Nova process as described in our charter document.

The Terra Nova test is currently administered to grades one through five in both the fall and the spring of each school year. Students in grades three to five are assessed with the Terra Nova test in addition to the school's internal interim assessments and the NYS assessment.

The modified testing schedule will require only students in grades one, two and three to take the Terra Nova test. First graders will be administered one Terra Nova test in the fall that will provide student base line scores and then another in the spring that will measure student growth throughout the year. The second grader and third grade students will take only a spring Terra Nova assessment that will measure growth form their previous year's spring scores.

## 5. Enrollment and Retention Targets

In 2011-12, the school made a good faith effort to attract and retain a greater enrollment of students with disabilities, English language learners, and students who are eligible applicants for the free and reduced price lunch program. The following list summarizes the actions taken.
